

Anthony Wood [1925-2022] F.H.S., F.R.S.A, was one of the finest heraldic artists in Britain in the 20th century. He was born in Birmingham and educated at Oundle and Birmingham College of Art. He served in the Army at the end of the Second World War. In 1947, he married Elizabeth Moore, a ballet dancer. With a young family to support, he combined work as a salesman for the publishers Thames & Hudson, with instruction in calligraphy and heraldic art from the eminent artists Daisy Alcock and William Gardner. He undertook commissions for officers at the College of Arms, Houses of Parliament, Guilds of the City of London, royalty, local authorities, armed services, schools, universities and private individuals. In 1981, he designed the coat of arms on the programme for the wedding of Prince Charles and Lady Diana Spencer.


In 1967, he founded at Reigate College of Art a full-time course in Calligraphy, Heraldry and Illuminating, then the only such course in the world. It trained many of today's notable heraldic artists and calligraphers. On retirement as senior lecturer in 1987, he moved to Somerset, where he still undertook commissions. In the same year, he co-founded the Society for Heraldic Arts.


He co-wrote *A European Armorial* with Rosemary Pinches. In 1996, he published his magisterial *Heraldic Art and Design*. Apart from his books, he wrote many articles for learned journals, and he was in demand as a lecturer.

His recreations included fencing and archery. In 1949, he won the Ancient Scorton Silver Arrow, and represented Great Britain at the World Archery Championship in Copenhagen the next year. He was twice Master of the Worshipful Company of Bowyers of London in the 1980s. He was made Freeman of the City of London.

The books, principally on art, history, calligraphy and heraldry, offered here were collected over a lifetime, and were used for research, teaching and as inspiration for his art and commissions. They include some books, which had belonged to his second wife, Margaret Fenemore Clark [d. 2005], herself also a gifted heraldic artist.

Not surprisingly, he designed his own bookplates, of which there are two types. The coats of arms in the one on the right were granted in 1974, while the other one is the earlier.




